## News Release

Hogan - Hansen, A Professional Corporation, today released an audit report on Wright County, Clarion, Iowa.

The County had local tax revenue of \$27,852,641 for the year ended June 30, 2018, which included \$2,422,260 in tax credits from the State. The County forwarded \$20,073,930 of the local tax revenue to townships, school districts, cities and other taxing bodies in the County.

The County retained \$7,778,711 of the local tax revenue to finance County operations, a 3.8% increase from the prior year. Other revenue included charges for service of \$1,211,503; operating grants, contributions and restricted interest of \$5,119,487; capital grants, contributions and restricted interest of \$2,549,162; local option sales tax of \$360,085; unrestricted investment earnings of \$234,908; and other general revenue of \$1,067,639.

Expenses for County operations for the year ended June 30, 2018 totaled \$22,334,603, an increase of 39.9% from the prior year. Expenses included \$6,997,590 for roads and transportation, \$6,006,728 for nonprogram and \$2,667,158 for public safety and legal services.
