

**For Release week of October 21, 2018:**

The Wright County Auditor's Office will be open on Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of pre-registering voters for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election and absentee voting.

Last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is Saturday, October 27<sup>th</sup>. Absentee ballots mailed back to Auditor's office must be postmarked by **November 5<sup>th</sup>** to be counted. You may absentee vote in person in the Auditor's office up to November 5<sup>th</sup>.

**IDENTIFICATION**

For elections held in 2018, pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification or sign an oath of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on Election Day – and voters who have moved precincts will also be required to provide proof of residence. A voter who cannot provide proof of identification may have their identity attested to by another voter registered in the precinct who has an approved form of identification. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification. The Wright County Auditor's Office will be open Saturday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. for the purpose of voting an absentee ballot for the November 6<sup>th</sup> General Election.
